Describe food to be sold:

The fee for one 10' frontage by 20' deep space is \$225 total for 2 days, and includes two 8' tables and benches. Application and fee must be received by Olinda Higashi no later than **July 21**. Make check payable to **Heiva I Kaua`i**, and mail with completed and signed application to Olinda Higashi, P O Box 464, Anahola, HI, 96703. Set-up starts at 7:00 am, to be completed by 9 am. Event hours are 10 am - 5 pm daily. Food waste including cooking oil must be removed from the park by the vendor. Cardboard and clean paper to be recycled by the vendor, not placed in the waste bin. Vendors will be mailed staff and vehicle entry passes after approval of application and receipt of payment. Food vendors are not allowed to pre-sell event admission tickets or conduct raffles.

No styrofoam or plastic utensils, plates or cups are allowed. Vendors must use food service-ware made from compostable material (paper, corn starch, bagass).

Vendors must get and display a Temporary Food Sale permit from the Kaua`i District Health Office at 3040 `Umi St., Lihu`e, HI, phone 808-241-3323. Permit application with a diagram of equipment lay-out must be submitted to DOH before July 21, 2017. Permits must be displayed at event. Sinks are provided for hand-washing only, as required by Department of Health and the County of Kaua`i. Although overnight security is provided, Heiva I Kaua`i is not liable for items missing or damaged.
